DETAILS OF WORK

Moved in service unit, killed well w/water. Located holes in casing from 1032'-1105'. Mixed and pumped 250 sacks Incor cement w/4% gel, 1% CaCl and 1/4#/sack flocc followed by 100 sacks Incor w/2% CaCl. Tapped cement at 942', drilled cement from 942'-1102'. Tested squeeze to 1000 psi for 15 minutes - okay. Circulated hole w/clean water to 1203'. Ran 123 joints 1.9" tubing w/slotted joint on bottom, landed at 3878. Nipped up Xmas tree. Well presently shut-in.
