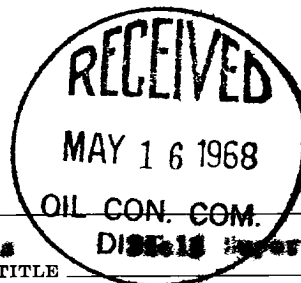

On 4-13-68, pulled 2 3/8" tubing but could not clean out open hole. Set DM retainer at 4399', squeeze cemented with 300 sacks of class A cement. Found holes in 7" casing at 700' and 820', set DM retainer at 630', squeeze cemented with 200 sacks of class C cement. On 4-16-68 drilled retainer and cement, casing held 1000 PSI. On 4-17-68 set whipstock and milled window 4499' - 4513', drilled to 4490'. Could not get away from 7" casing. On 4-19-68 set DM retainer at 4447', squeeze cemented with 150 sacks of class A cement, 10% sand, 2% calcium chloride. On 4-20-68 drilled retainer and cement. Ran Totco's 4528' - 4 1/4", 4570' - 3 1/4", 4723' - 3 1/2". On 4-21-68 3440' TD. Ran 167 jts 4 1/2" - 10.300 J casing set at 3433', cemented first stage with 150 sacks Class C .81 Haled 9, second stage 150 sacks Halliburton Light cement. Ran temperature survey top cement 3950'. On 4-23-68 perforated Point Lookout Zone, 3226' - 3362'. Sand-water fractured with 33,000 gals water, 40,000 lbs sand, 100 - 7/8" balls. Perforated Cliff-house Zone 4844' - 4916', fractured with 24,500 gals water, 24,000 lbs sand, fifty 7/8" balls. On 4-24-68 ran 174 jts 2 3/8" 4.74 J tubing, set at 3283'.

Instructions
