Dear Mr. Gorham:

It has come to our attention that we recently approved the drilling unit on your #19 State well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2-30N-8W without proper authority. You have dedicated the north half of Section 2-30N-8W containing 328.4 acres. Rule 6-A of Order R-128-D specifies that any unit containing less than 316 or more than 320 acres is a non-standard unit and requires administrative approval from Mr. Macey, as set out in Rule 6-B.

As this well was connected 12-15-55 it has been producing since that time without proper authority so that I would advise you to take care of this matter immediately.

It has come to our attention that we recently approved the drilling unit on your #12 State well in the N 1/4 Section 2-107-24 without proper authority. You have dedicated the north half of Section 2-30N-1-W containing 320.4 acres. This dedication Order R-118-D specifies that any unit containing less than 160 acres more than 320 acres is a non-standard unit and requires administrative approval from Mr. Macoy, as set out in Rule 4-B.

As this well was connected 12-15-35 it has been producing since that time without proper authority so that I would advise you to take care of this matter immediately.
