In order to meet New Mexico Oil & Gas Conservation Commission requirements, we propose to perform the following work on this well: kill well w/2% CaCl₂ water, set retrievable bridge plug at 1450' & dump 2 sacks of sand on top of B.P., perforate casing at 1410' w/6 holes, run Baker retrievomatic packer on 2-3/8" tbg & set at 1380', circulate thru perfs at 1410' to surface if possible. Squeeze off Farmington sand thru perfs at 1410' w/180 sacks Type A cement/heated with 2% calcium chloride & Halad 9, followed with 20 sacks Type A cmt. When 150 sacks cement is away behind the pipe shut the surface casing in & stage balance of cement to 1000#. Reverse out excess cement in tubing & casing, pull 2-3/8" tbg, check to be sure Farmington sand has been squeezed off. Pressure test squeeze job to 2000#, retrieve bridge plug, run 1-1/4" tbg to a depth of 6660', install tree & swab well in.

Instructions
