

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 28, 1967, for permission to dually complete its Reid "A" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 17th day of September, 1967, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Reid "A" Well No. 1 located in Unit A of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing, respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A, Article 11 of the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, the Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of Rule 11-A, located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 12 West, New Mexico, San Juan County, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Hessavada Pool and the Gasco-Palacio Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of September, 1944, the Commission do hereby order that:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-A of the Constitution of the State of New Mexico.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that the operations of other persons have been duly notified.
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed well completion will not cause water to flow into the gas well.
- (5) That the location of the proposed well completion is in accordance with good conservation practice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, Inc., the same is hereby authorized to carry out the provisions of Rule 11-A, located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 12 West, New Mexico, San Juan County, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Hessavada Pool and the Gasco-Palacio Pool through the existing annulus and the tubing, casing, and wellhead.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take such action as may be necessary to protect and maintain the annulus during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Gasco-Palacio Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That publication of this order is hereby required for the purpose of giving notice to all persons who may be affected thereby.
