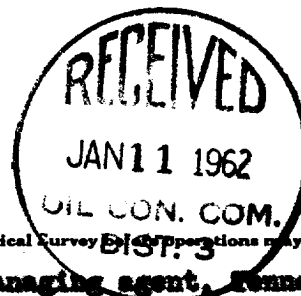

DETAILS OF WORK

Running and cementing production casing as follows:

Ran 205 joints of 4-1/2", 11.6# and 9.5#, J-55 casing and set at 6604'. Stage collar set at 2017' and cemented in two stages. First stage: cemented with 250 sacks Incoor with .9% Haled 9. Second stage: cemented with 50 sacks Incoor-Diamix 1:1 with 6% gal. WOC 24 hours. Pressure tested casing to 3000 pounds for 30 minutes. Pressure held o.k.
