RE: Violations on the Hare #1, #2, #3 and #4 wells all located in G-23-29N-11W

Dear Mr. Kendall:

Kendall and Associates, Inc. was notified by telephone on July 16, 1992 of violations on the Hare #3 and #4 wells. No corrective action has been taken as of this date. The Kendall and Associates Hare #3 well has excessive and unnecessary oil staining about the wellhead, a partially filled chemical barrel is also on location. The worst stained material is to be removed from the wellhead area and either remediated on location or hauled to a commercial landfarm. The chemical barrel is to be removed and disposed of properly. The Kendall and Associates Hare #4 well has excessive oil around the wellhead which is to be removed and remediated or hauled to a landfarm. Stained material from a small spill at the separator is also to be remediated, not covered with clean material. Kendall and Associates Hare #1 and #2 wells were determined to be lacking proper well signs on August 17, 1992. Kendall and Associates has 30 days to correct the violations cited above or face fines of \$1,000 per day per violation from the date of this letter.
