

Greenwood Resources Inc. requests administrative approval for an exception to the well location requirements under Rule 3 of the Cha Cha (Gallup) Pool Rules for an unorthodox location due to topographic reasons, in order to drill our Kirtland No. 14-1 well. The original location for this well was 510' FNL & 510' FEL of Sec 14 T29S R15W; this location fell on the present road used for access to the area and within 20' of a drainage ditch used to drain the area to the north. In conversation with the land owner the location was moved to the only uncultivated area which was 50' northwest from the drainage ditch. All areas to the southwest are cultivated.

It is felt that this location is in the best interest of the land and mineral interests and will also allow the orderly development of this tract with minimum surface interference. Greenwood is the offset operator in all but one direction from this well.
