PERMIT AND LICENSE

Date: July 3, 1990

That subject to the provisions and conditions contained in Chapter 22 of the Farmington City Code and subject to compliance with the conditions of the Special Use Permit granted by the City Council at the June 5, 1990 City Council Work Session and ratified at the June 26, 1990 City Council Meeting, BHP Petroleum (Americas) Inc. is hereby granted a permit and license to drill a well in search of oil and/or gas to the Fruitland Coal formation on the following location:

1744 feet from the west line and 1020 feet from the south line (SE1/4 SW1/4) of Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 13 West N.M.P.M., to an approximate depth of 1,507 feet.


This permit shall be valid for a period of one year and so long thereafter as oil or gas shall be produced or until such time as the permittee has abandoned operations. Providing, however, no operations shall be commenced until the permittee shall have complied with Chapter 22 of the Farmington City Code.
