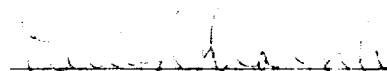
Dear Mr. Arnold:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 25, 1960, addressed to Alfred E. McLane, Attention: Mr. L. Clark Morgan, regarding the R. E. Jackson No. 2 Sullivan well located in the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 30, Township 29 North, Range 10 West.

We have advised Mr. Wiedemer and Mr. Jackson that the McLane Estate wished for the well to be plugged and abandoned, and Mr. Wiedemer as a courtesy, advised that he had made arrangements with a New Mexico operator to plug and abandon the well for the salvage value. I assume that Mr. Wiedemer has taken further action on this matter and if same has been done, I would appreciate it if either Mr. Wiedemer or Mr. Jackson would file your Form O-10 showing that the well has been plugged and abandoned.
