DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a depth of 990 feet with cable tool rig, December 19, 1951. On this date operations were discontinued due to bad roads caused by heavy rains and snow which made delivery of fuel and water to location impossible. It is hereby requested that operator be allowed to suspend operations until weather is sufficiently improved to open roads and resume operations. Contractor's rig will be left on location in order to resume operations at earliest possible date.


I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
