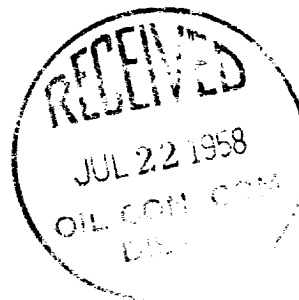

DETAILS OF WORK

Rosa Unit Well No. 33. On July 9, 1958, 5-1/2" casing was landed at 4317' with 100 sacks 4½ gal cement followed by 75 sacks neat. Casing and water shut-off were tested to 3000 pounds for thirty minutes, which held with no drop in pressure. Top cement 3250' by temperature survey.
