DETAILS OF WORK

Rosa Unit Well No. 33 was spudded on June 19, 1958, and on June 20, 1958, 8-5/8" casing was landed at 493' with 300 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut-off were tested with 400 pounds pressure for thirty minutes which held with no drop in pressure.
