The well is now on the scout letter as the #12-15 Rosa Unit instead of the #11-15. Tom Dugan verified the location to be as the plat indicates.

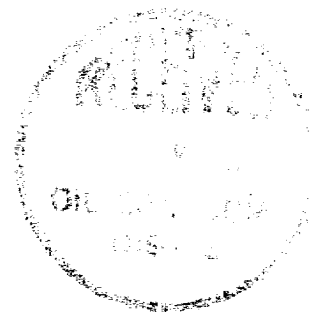

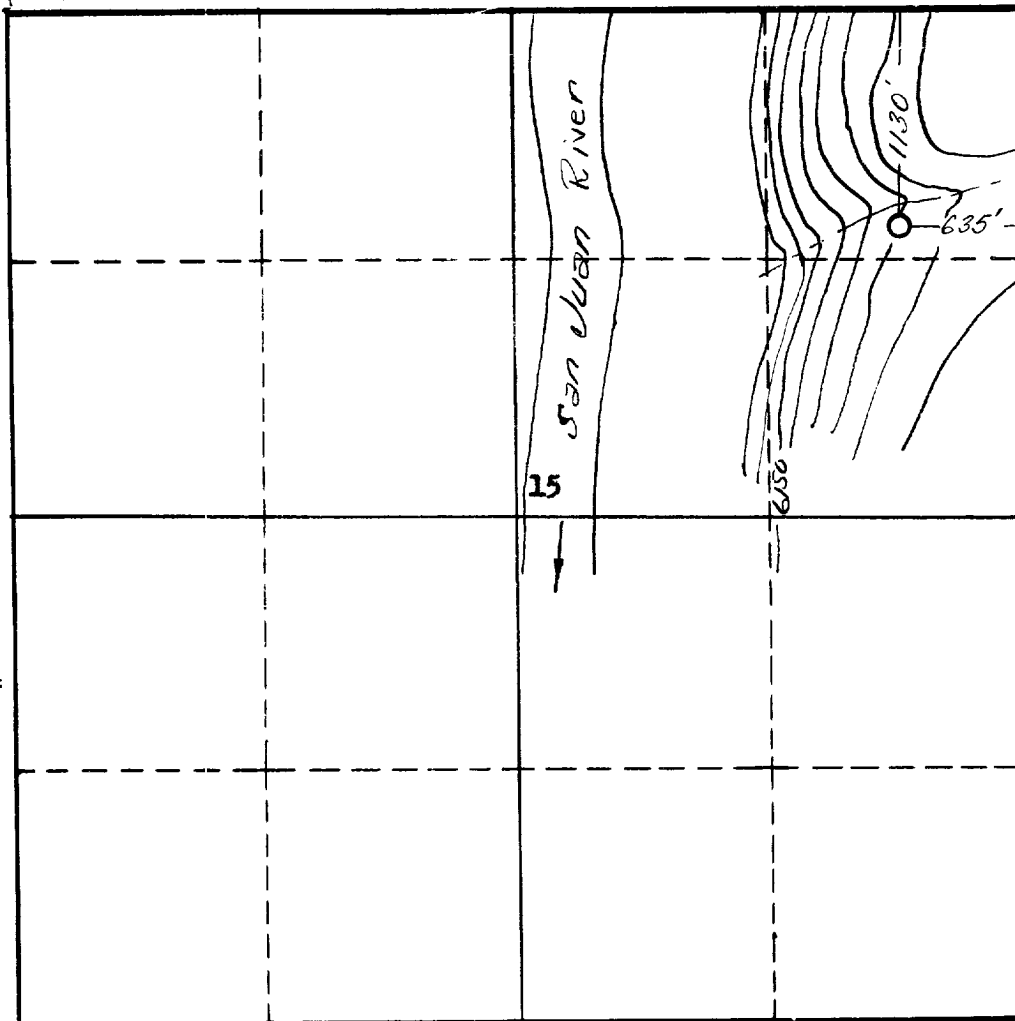
