It should be noted, however, that the subject bond will remain in effect as to any property or wells acquired, started or drilled by the principal prior to August 6, 1962.

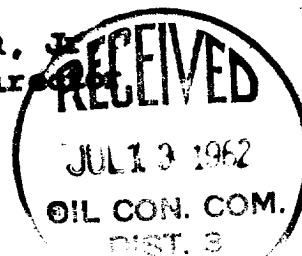

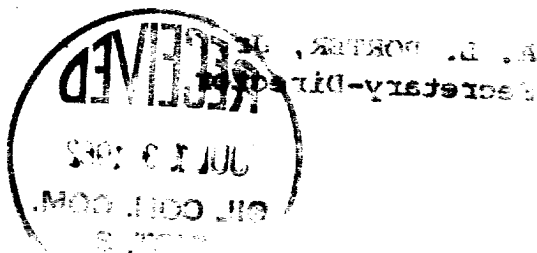
Gentlemen:

Gentlemen:

We have received a Notice of Intention to Drill for the Stella Dysart, #1-9 well. Our files contain a copy of a letter dated July 11, 1962, addressed to the United States Casualty Company, 175 Whitney Ave., New Haven 5, Connecticut and written by A. L. Porter, Jr., New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. This letter acknowledges receipt of a request for cancellation of Stella Dysart's \$10,000, Blanket Plugging Bond. The letter also states that in compliance with the request the bond was cancelled effective August 6, 1962, therefore, although the Bond still covers any unplugged wells owned by Stella Dysart which were drilled prior to August 6, 1962, it is not in effect for any wells drilled after that date. Therefore we cannot approve your Notice of Intention to Drill.

It will be necessary that you either reinstate the Blanket Bond or secure a \$5,000. One Well Bond to cover this operation.

No drilling operations of any kind should be carried on at this location until you have received an approved Notice of Intention to Drill.

We have received your letter of November 16, 1962 for the Stella System, 11-3-62. Our files contain a copy of a letter dated July 11, 1962, addressed to the United States (San Juan County), 115 Wilshire Ave., New Haven 2, Connecticut and written by A. L. Norton, Jr., New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. This letter acknowledges receipt of a request for cancellation of Stella System's \$10,000, Blanket Pinking Bond. The letter also states that in compliance with the request the bond was cancelled effective August 6, 1962, therefore, although the bond will cover any undrilled wells owned by Stella System which were drilled after August 6, 1962, it is not in effect for any wells drilled after that date. Therefore we cannot approve your Notice of Intention to Drill.

It will be necessary that you either reinstate the Blanket Bond or secure a \$2,000. One will bond to cover this operation.

No drilling operations of any kind should be carried on at this location until you have received an approved Notice of Intention to Drill.
