MEC efforts to begin workover operations on this well have been delayed by the Carson National Forest Service and the State Historic Preservation Office in an attempt to determine significant cultural resources existing along the Bancos Canyon Road which are under the stewardship of the National Forest Service. Dr. Richard P.
