Gentlemen:

Mitchell Energy Corporation respectfully requests an extension be granted for the completion dates of the Rosa Unit Nos. 82, 83, and 84 wells. These wells are required by your department to be completed or abandoned by August 24, 1989.

We are aware that previous extensions have been granted for these wells, but due to the continued depressed economic conditions of the oil and gas industry, we respectfully request another extension. As stated before in previous extension requests, log analysis shows a good probability that commercial production can be achieved in each of the subject wellbores. Since the continued search for a suitable gas market for these wells has had little success and the fact that all wellbores have been temporarily abandoned as per your requirements, we propose that these wellbores be left in their current condition until such time as a suitable economic market can be found for these wells. We also propose that yearly updates on the status of these wells continue to be filed with your office.
