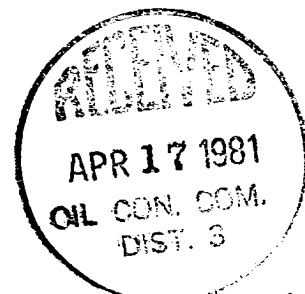
The attached Form C-102 illustrates the topographical problems encountered in selecting a suitable well site. The selected location is only 700' from the East line of Section 28.
