

Administrative Order NSL-2909-A

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated November 13, 1990 to amend Division Administrative Order NSL-2909, which authorized your Rosa Unit Well No. 296 to be drilled at an unorthodox coal gas well location 1190 feet from the North line and 670 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 12, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding as a result of a resurvey of the surface location, it was found that the actual location is 1230 feet from the North line and 680 feet from the West line (Unit D) of said Section 12.

Division Administrative Order NSL-2909 is hereby amended to reflect said location change. Further, all provisions of said Order NSL-2909 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
