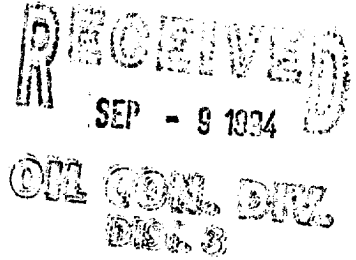

Dear Frank:

Northwest Pipeline Corporation is requesting approval of the C-104 for the subject well without the initial packer leakage test. In an effort to conserve natural gas, we propose testing the permanent production packer immediately following first delivery of the well. The test will be conducted while the well is producing to the pipeline as follows:

1. Both formations will be shut in for at least 3 days.
2. The lower zone will be first delivered to the pipeline and the SITP and SICP for the upper zone will monitored for two days.
3. After the lower zone production period of two days, the upper zone will be first delivered.

The packer test described above will be submitted to the NMOCD, on an approved packer leakage test form, as soon as possible.
