Dear Mr. Thompson:

We are in receipt of your application to commingle the Pictured Cliff (PC) and Fruitland Coal in the Schalk 33 #2 wellbore dated 6/1/2000. Since you are allocating nothing to the PC and you submitted data that indicates there is no change in the well's production decline after completing the PC and also there is no change in the BTU values of the gas stream we see no reason to apply for commingling if the interval is non-productive. If you agree, please file a sundry notice stating that the PC is non-productive and does not contribute to the overall production of the well and hence no commingling approval will be required.
