Rs: Packer leakage test for the Rosa Unit #137 PC/MV

Dear Frank:

Northwest Pipeline Corporation is requesting approval of the C-104 for the subject well without one initial packer leakage test. In an effort to conserve natural gas, we propose testing the permanent production packer immediately following first delivery of the well. The test will be conducted while the well-test pipeline as follows:

- Following the IP test, both formations will be shut in for at least 3 days.
- The lower sone will be first delivered to the pipeline and the SITP and SICP for the lower zone will monitored for two days.
- After the lower zone production period of two days, the upper access to be a stable period.

The packer test described above will be submitted to the NMOCD packer leadings on their as some as possible.
