

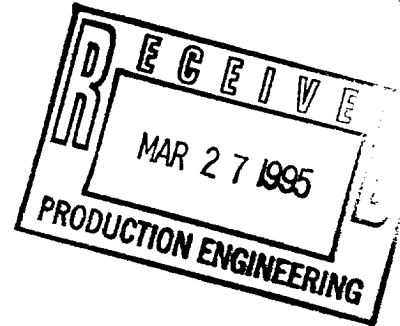

Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to your application dated March 16, 1995 on behalf of the operator, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, for an unorthodox gas well location for both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin Dakota Pools for the proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 148. Said well to be drilled 445 feet from the South line and 2460 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 2, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

All of said irregular Section 2 being a non-standard 356.26-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both pool is to be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 2(a)4 and 2(c) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location and non-standard gas spacing and proration units are hereby approved.
