



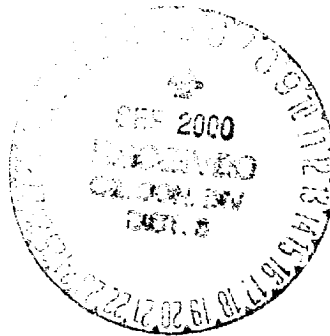

Administrative Order NSL-4505

Dear Ms. Ross:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated August 23, 2000; and (ii) the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") records in Santa Fe: all concerning Williams Production Company's request for an unorthodox Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for the proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 354 (API No. 30-039-26412) to be drilled 2120 feet from the North line and 2015 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 19, Township 31 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 19 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
