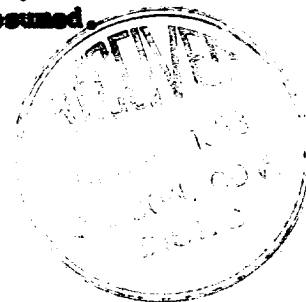

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 12:45 A.M., March 12, 1953. On March 13, 1953, 10-3/4" casing was landed at 262 feet and cemented with 190 sacks of cement. Plug down at 5:41 A.M., March 13, 1953. At 8:30 P.M., March 14, 1953, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Forty-four feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
