DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 28, 1952, 7" casing was landed at 3976 feet and cemented with 744 sacks of Bridg-st and 100 sacks of cement. Plug down at 6:00 P.M., February 28, 1952. At 6:00 P.M., March 1, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1200 lbs. pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Sixty-eight feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1200 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
