DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded at 3:00 A.M., February 5, 1952, and on February 8, 1952, 10-3/4" casing was landed at 582 feet and cemented with 350 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Cement plug down at 11:24 P.M., February 8, 1952. At 11:30 A.M., February 10, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes, with no drop in pressure. Fifty feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 500 pounds for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure during this test and drilling operations were resumed.
