

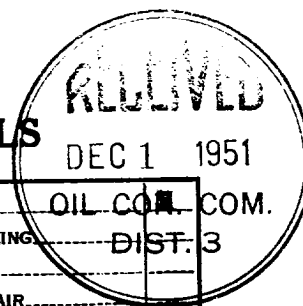

On November 24, 1951: Ran 133 joints of 7" 20# J-55 casing (4195') set at 4195' with 300 sacks regular cement and three sacks Floccals. Top of cement by Temperature Survey 2490'.

Held 1000# for ten hours.

Casing stuck at 4195' when circulation lost running pipe.
