ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southern Union Production Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 7, 1962, for permission to dually complete its Federal Well No. 1-31 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

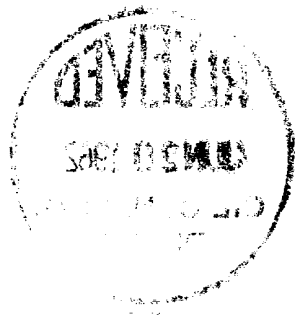
Now, on this 11th day of June, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objections have been received from offset operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Federal Well No. 1-31 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.
