

DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was spudded on March 8, 1962. 8 5/8" casing was set at 296' with 200 sacks Incor cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 400 psi for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Reduced hole to 7 7/8" at 296' and resumed drilling.
