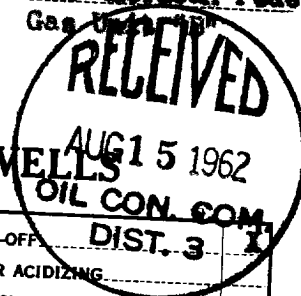

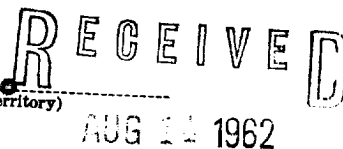

The above well was drilled to a total depth of 6765'. 4-1/2" casing was set at 6760' with a stage collar at 3910'. First stage cemented with 275 sacks Inco cement containing 4% gel and 1-1/2 lbs. per sack medium Tuf Plug followed by 100 sacks Inco cement. Cemented second stage with 950 sacks neat Inco cement containing 4% gel. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 3,000 psi. Held o.k. Drilled out stage collar and tested first stage with 3,000 psi. Held o.k.

Currently waiting on completion rig.
