

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposed work:
Set 30 feet of 2 3/8" surface casing and cement to surface.
Drill with rotary to approximate total depth of 150 feet or through sandstone formation. Set 15" production casing at total depth and cement with 2 1/2 sacks. Set two-stage cement collar around annulus 100 feet below measured cliff formation and cement with 1 1/2 sacks.
Perforate sandstone for oil. Ann-water free with 100,000 gal. and 10,000 gal. water. Run 2 3/8" tubing.
Lease one-half of section 34, 320 acres, dedicated to oil.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


