Revised of Order No. R-565 for Non-
Standard Proration Unit, Aztec-Pictured
Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard unit comprising the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) (or Lots 3, 4, NE/4 SW/4, SE/4 SW/4) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Ludwick #7 Well is located 1650 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, N.M.P.M., and was dually completed as a gas well on June 10, 1956 in the Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs formations.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 152.60 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.



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Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 6 (b) Revised of Order No. R-565, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.

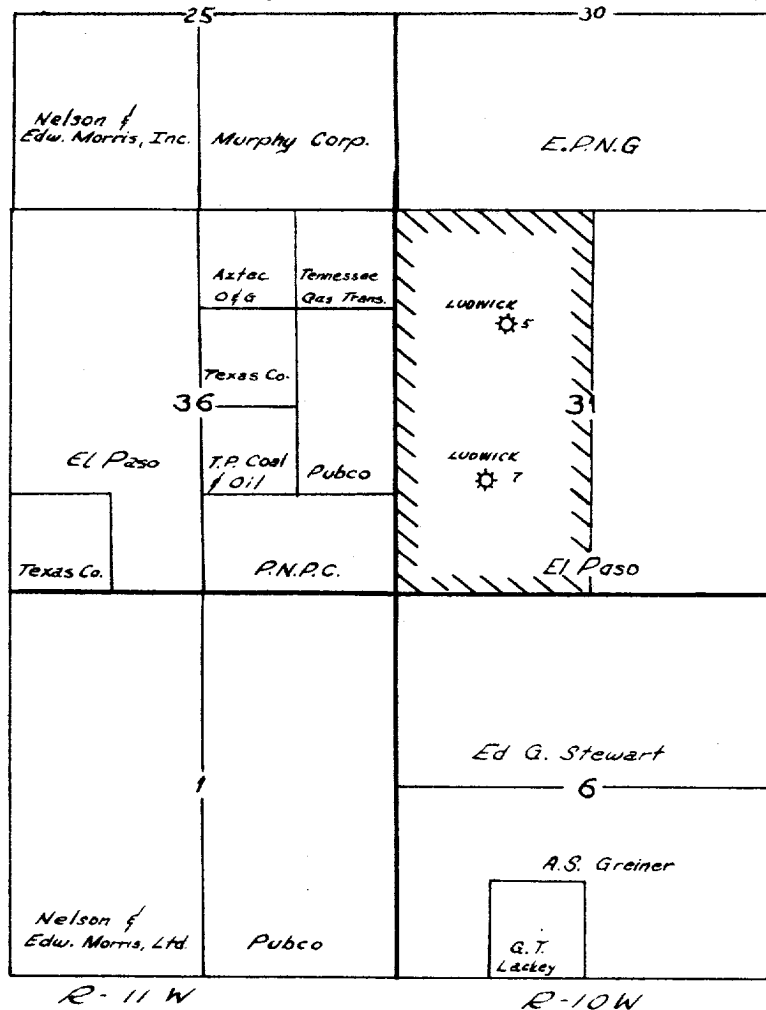
