G 1. That the Astec-Summons No. 1 well, located 1970 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from ~~the East line~~ of Section 32, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, was completed January 8, 1947 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on April 29, 1947.

2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 160 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

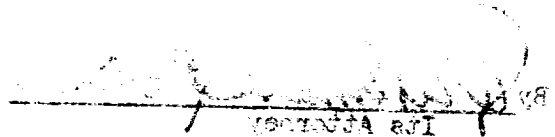

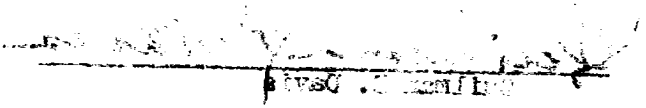

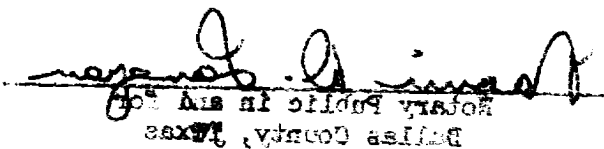
