 Jan 23 joints (756') 5 1/2", 15.50#, J-55 casing as a liner, set from 4252' to 5007' with burns liner hanger (top of liner at 4252'). Cemented with 62.5 sacks regular cement, 62.5 sacks Pozmix, 16# Floccel, and 2# Gel.
 Held 1000# 30 minutes.
 Actual top of cement at 4240', no temperature survey could be run down in liner.
