El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) (or NE/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, Lots 1 and 2) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Ludwick #5 Well, located 1500 feet from the North line and 1600 feet from the West line of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on March 1, 1955, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system March 3, 1955.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 153.80 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may resonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which agreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.




