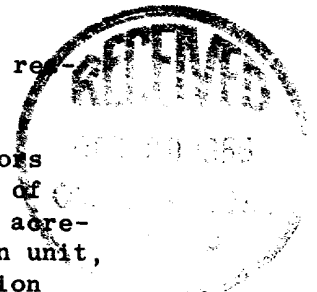

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) (or NE/4 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4, Lots 1 and 2) of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. The Ludwick #5 Well, located 1500 feet from the North line and 1600 feet from the West line of Section 31, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on March 1, 1955, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system March 3, 1955.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 153.80 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.



Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provisions of Rule 6 (b) Revised of Order No. R-565, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.



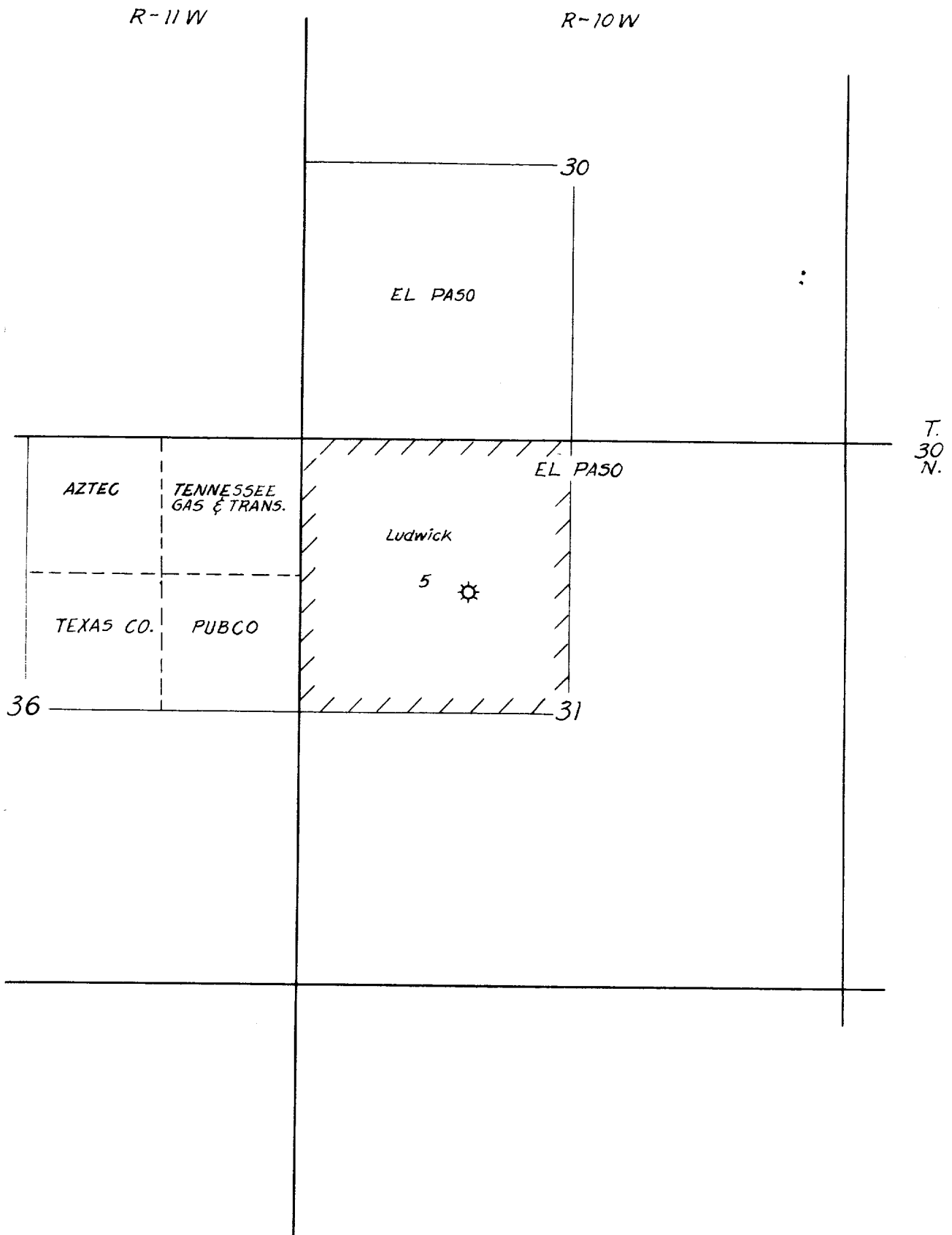
