Dear Mr. Trigg:

We received copies of Notice of Intention to Drill on your #1-31 Federal FC well located 790 feet from the North and 1820 feet from the West line of Section 31-30N-11W.

We note that your dedicated unit contains 170.25 acres. This excess acreage makes this unit non-standard and in order to comply with Order R-565 which is the proration order in the Aztec Pictured Cliffs Pool, it will be necessary that you use the following procedure:

A letter should be written to Mr. A. L. Porter, Director of the Commission Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico stating that this unit is non-standard because of a variation in legal subdivisions and that the Northwest Quarter of Section 31 contains 170.25 acres. Exception should be asked under the provisions of Rule 6, Paragraph B of Order R-565-C. Copies of your application should also be sent to any offset operators owning interests in offset acreage, or in lieu thereof, waivers from these offsets should be furnished.

You need not delay drilling your well because of failure of compliance with this rule; however we will not be able to approve a C-110, Authorization to Transport form on this well until administrative approval has been secured.
