DETAILS OF WORK

This well was originally completed in the Mesa Verde formation in September, 1952 and subsequently cleaned out in September, 1953. Since the Mesa Verde formation is no longer producing, it is intended to shut off the Mesa Verde by plugging back to 4075' with 200 sacks cement. The casing will then be perforated at 2000' and 2450' and cement circulated behind the casing between perforations. After cleaning out the casing to 2700', the Pictured Cliffs formation will be perforated and water fractured
