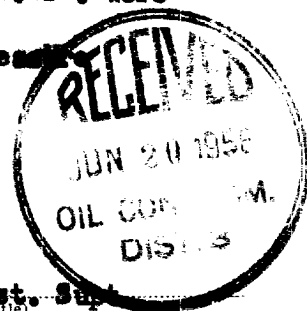

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well Spudded June 17, 1956

Drilled to TD 186' reamed to 146' Set (4 jts) 127' of 10 3/4" 32.75# Elect-weld Casing, landed at 141' cemented w/ 150 sacks. Casing was pressured to 500# for 1 hr with no drop in pressure. After cement set, plug was drilled and runs on B.O.P. were closed and pressured to 500# for 30 minutes with no appreciable drop in pressure. Drilling ahead was resumed.
