Gentlemen:

This will confirm telephone notification to you this date concerning our plans to shut in E. E. Elliott "B" No. 4 (Unit P, Section 27, T-30-N, R-9-W, San Juan County, New Mexico) in the Blanco Pictured Cliffs Field for interference test data. The well was shut in due to gas scheduling January 25, 1960, and opened and blown to atmosphere February 3, 1960, to assure that the well bore was free of liquids. It was then shut in and the test started on that date. We anticipate keeping the well shut-in for a period of up to one year.

We are making arrangements to lock the wellhead valves and tag the well and sales meter to eliminate the possibility of the well being opened inadvertently. It should not be produced or blown to atmosphere until subsequently advised by Pan American that the test has been completed. It is our understanding that El Paso intends to exercise their best efforts to shift production from E. E. Elliott "B" No. 4 to E. E. Elliott "B" Nos. 5 and 6 on the same lease.
