Well was filed March 19, 1962 as Riecke Gas Unit No. 1 in SW/4 of Section 25, but location and well name is being changed by this form.

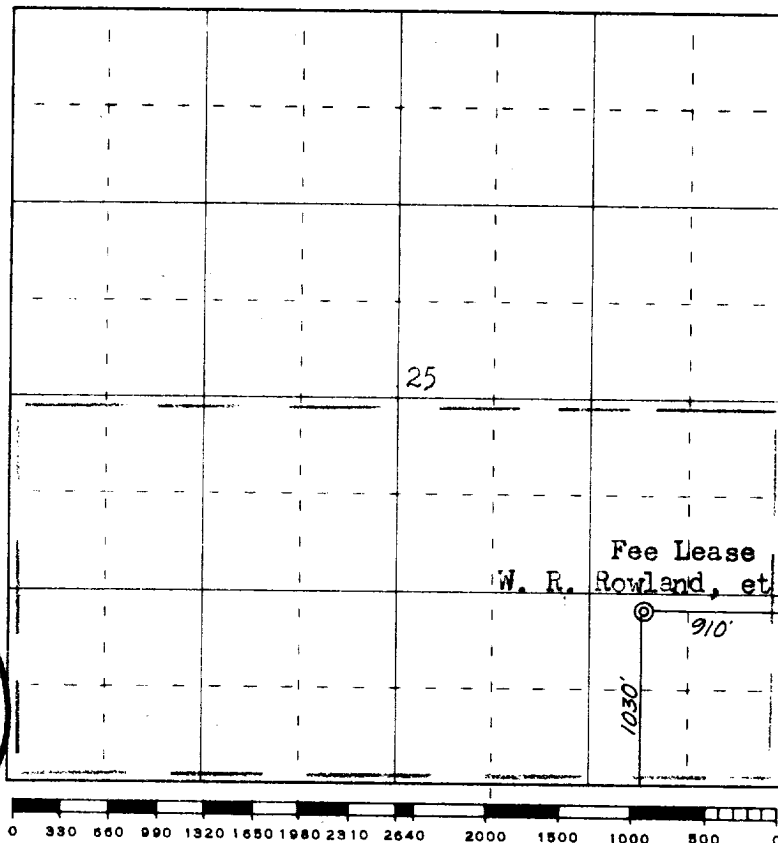
