DETAILS OF WORK

On June 29, 1952, 7" casing was landed at 4131 feet and cemented with 300 sacks of cement. Plug down at 4:30 P.M., June 29, 1952. At 1:00 P.M., July 2, 1952, casing and water shut-off were tested at 1000 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Thirty-six feet of solid cement were drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested at 1000 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
