I am writing to you concerning a recent inspection of the Rio Grande River at the mouth of the San Juan River. The inspection was conducted by the New Mexico Department of Environment on September 13, 1981. The inspection revealed that the water quality in the river was excellent. The water temperature was approximately 68 degrees Fahrenheit, and the dissolved oxygen level was approximately 8.5 mg/l. The pH level was approximately 7.5. The water clarity was excellent, and there were no visible signs of pollution or degradation.
