

THE APPLICATION OF REDFERN AND HERD, INCORPORATED, FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS JOHNSTON WELL NO. 1 LOCATED IN THE NE/4 SE/4 OF SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE MESAVERDE FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE FLORA VISTA-MESAVERDE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Redfern and Herd, Incorporated, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 19, 1962, for permission to dually complete its Johnston Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Flora Vista-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 8th day of February, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Redfern and Herd, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Johnston Well No. 1 located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 28, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Mesaverde formation adjacent to the Flora Vista-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.
