Gentlemen:

Oil Conservation Commission Order R-333-A relating to gas well testing specifies that any well connected to a gas transportation facility shall have an annual deliverability test run as indicated by order R-333-A. If for any reason it is not possible to run an annual deliverability test, then a Form C-122-A should be submitted on the well in triplicate, showing why it was not possible to test the well. If the reasons are adjudged reasonable by the Commission then the well will be assigned a temporary allowable based upon its initial potential test. However, if no information is filed the well will not be placed on the proration schedule and will be shut off production at the beginning of the first proration period and shall remain off until such time as the matter has been taken care of.

We find that your Company has not complied with the above regulations on the following well:

#1 Waggoner, SW 29-30N-12W

If our information as indicated is incorrect, please notify this office.

If the above information is received by this office by February 1, 1955, your wells will go on the first proration schedule, which period begins March 1, 1955. If the information has not been filed by February 1, your wells will not be placed on the proration schedule and the pipeline company will be notified to shut your wells in as of that date.
