## DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole on September 28, 1959 and drilled to 205'. 8-5/8" casing was set at 205' with 160 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated 17 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, casing and water shut off were tested with 400 psi for thirty minutes which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 205' and resumed drilling operations.
