B. B. Elliott "B" Well No. 5 was 9 1/2 inch casing at 2741 feet with 550 sacks 6% gel cement followed by 25 sacks neat cement. Oil started out 60 sacks. After waiting on cement, casing and water shot to the surface with 9000 pounds pressure for thirty minutes with no drop in pressure.

Resumed. Held with no drop in pressure. Resumed

8-5/8" casing was set at 301 feet with 240 sacks of cement, circulated out 50 sacks. After waiting on cement for 24 hours, casing and water shut off were tested with 500
