I was recently notified by your Aztec office that the above-named well was over-produced in violation of Order R-565-C and was to be shut-in. This well over-produced because of the fact that it only had forty acres designated, therefore, has a short acreage factor at the present time. I am making preparation to apply for a hearing to designate more acreage to this well. This is a very small well, located in the Fulcher-Kutz Pictured Cliffs gas pool and is in a low deliverability, low pressure area, which produces considerable water.

A prolonged period of shut-in would cause the well to log-off with water and this would necessitate moving a rig back on the well to put it back on production. I am therefore asking temporary relief from shut-in until the above-mentioned hearing can be arranged. I am asking this relief under the terms of Order R-565, Rule #12, which states that the Commission may allow over-production to be made up at a lesser rate than would be the case if the well were completely shut-in, if it is shown that complete shut-in would result in material damage to the well.
