DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate muddling jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Well was drilled to a total depth of 5100 feet with rotary tools. Shot formation from 4335 to 5100 feet open with 1766 quarts Hercules slow detonating explosive. Well was cleaned out to total depth with gas and 2" tubing was landed at 5055 feet. Well shut in 41 hours. Shut in casing pressure 1264 psi. After 6-hour blow down well measured 5690 MCF per 24 hours through 2" outlet with pitot tube August 16, 1952. Well was shut in for pipe line connection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
